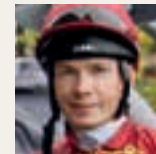

the FARM

Tweenhills has long been regarded as one of the finest stock farms in the Ledbury country in north west Gloucestershire.





Tweenhills lies between the Malvern Hills and the River Sever in prime dairy and beef country where stock famously thrives.

Now covering over 600 acres of the finest permanent pasture, the paddocks at Tweenhills and surrounding farms are sheltered by ancient hedgerows and magnificent oaks. They are farmed in strict rotation with our resident Aberdeen Angus suckler herd and during the winter months the farm is grazed extensively by sheep.

Since the conversion of Tweenhills to a public stud in 1995, four neighbouring properties have been added. Corsend Farm, Chargy Hill Farm, Catsbury and now Slopers Farm, an organic dairy farm on our northern boundary, and together they make up over 600 acres of the finest stock rearing land.

Tweenhills Farm is home to the new stallion unit and visiting mares, Corsend Farm houses our modern foaling unit, Chargy Hill is kept predominantly as a young stock farm with a range of winter barns, and Slopers Farm houses our calving unit and is retained as the private stud for resident mares and foals.

Several outdoor arenas with Polytrack surface were added last year for winter turnout and developments have continued apace in 2015. The construction of a new stud office and reception area, visitors parking, eight-horse covered walker as well as new nursery paddocks, roadways and winter turnout barns have recently been completed. We have also just installed a new twelve box isolation unit at Catsbury in time to receive arrivals from both the sales and abroad.

All together we have an excellent world class facility on this, the most fertile of ground.

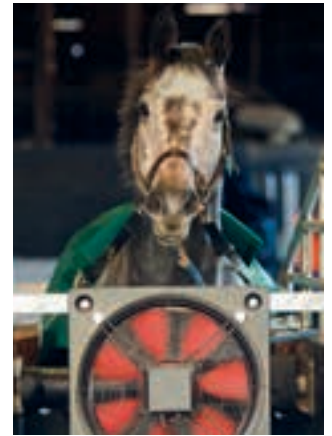
