



Tweenhills has long been regarded as one of the finest stock farms in the Ledbury country in north west Gloucestershire.













Tweenhills lies between the Malvern Hills and the River Severn in prime horse and cattle country.

Now covering over 650 acres of the finest permanent pasture, the paddocks at Tweenhills and surrounding farms are sheltered by ancient hedgerows and magnificent oaks. They are farmed in strict rotation with our resident Aberdeen Angus suckler herd of over 160 cattle and during the winter months the farm is grazed extensively by sheep. Indeed, Tweenhills has diversified recently and is now supplying Premiership side Gloucester Rugby with its beef.

Since the conversion of Tweenhills to a public stud in 1995, four neighbouring properties have been added. Corsend Farm, Chargy Hill Farm, Catsbury and Slopers Farm and together they provide the finest stock rearing land. Tweenhills Farm is home to the stallion unit and visiting mares, Corsend Farm houses our modern foaling unit and Chargy Hill is kept predominantly as a young stock farm with a range of winter barns. Slopers Farm houses our calving unit and is retained as the private stud for resident mares and foals. A twelve box isolation unit was recently installed at Catsbury.

Several outdoor arenas with Polytrack surface have been added over the past few years for winter turnout. We have recently opened our new stud office and reception area. An eight horse covered walker, nursery paddocks, roadway and winter turnout barns were also added in 2016.

All together we have an excellent world class facility on this, the most fertile of ground.


