The farm grows its own oats and barley, as well as the vast majority of its hay and haylage.

In the last twelve months there has also been investment in new stallion boxes and facilities, new loading ramps, re-fenced stallion paddocks and the installation of an owners reception and hospitality area.

Charlie is responsible for paddock and machinery maintenance, stud photography and also assists Werner with the Aberdeen Angus suckler herd.








Tweenhills boasts its own herd of Aberdeen Angus cattle that produce the farm's own brand of beef.


