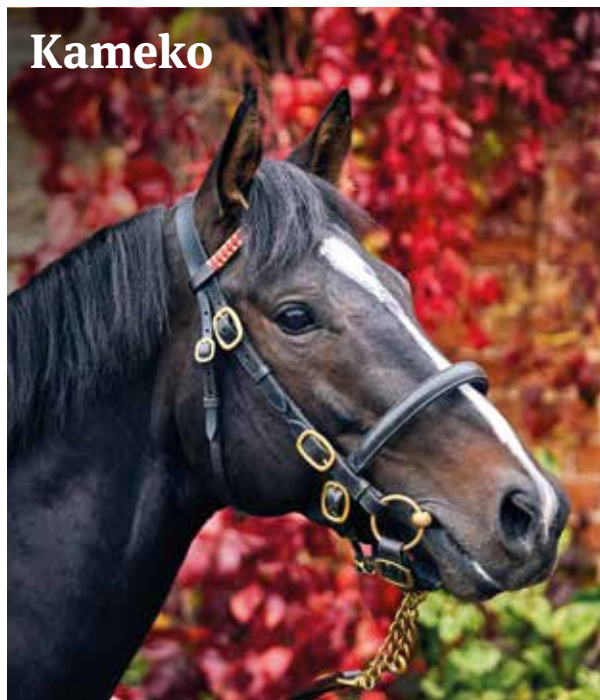

Then we pray that when the cheques and balances are measured at the end of the year, nature and nurture have combined to deliver the goods, whether in the sales ring or on the racecourse.

Sometimes when all the stars align the outcome is huge success for another party on the racecourse but little reward for the breeder in the sales ring. The breeder has suffered the costs and the risks but received none of the reward. It's here we have decided to step in with an initiative that will pay immediate dividends for several lucky breeders in 2022 and many more thereafter. We want to reward those breeders who breed the best racehorses by our stallions regardless of the price they achieve in the ring.

When Zoustar, Lightning Spear and Roaring Lion all landed at Tweenhills in 2019 we decided on launching the initiative "Your Success = Our Success", and because of stellar results in 2021, we have now decided to reward those breeders who enjoyed such wonderful success even further by bringing the scheme forward a year.

As a result Theakston Stud (breeders of Chipotle by Havana Gold), Ringfort Stud (breeders of Fearby by Havana Gold), Knox & Wells Ltd & R Devlin (breeders of Pyledriver by Harbour Watch) and Limestone and Tara Studs (breeders of A Case Of You by Hot Streak) will all receive credits to the value of those nominations that resulted in the British, Irish, French and German Stakes winners in 2021 conceived at Tweenhills, for use against nomination fees to Qatar Racing stallions in 2022. Next year with Zoustar, Spear, and Lion's first runners hitting the track, the list is going to grow and grow as our successes together continue to be rewarded both on the track and in the breeding shed.

None of this would be possible without Sheikh Fahad and his brothers, their support and the love they have for our game and business; that and the support of the utterly brilliant team here at Tweenhills, who look forward to welcoming you again in 2022. We have much to look forward to!

The Farm & Tweenhills Angus

Tweenhills continues to develop its reputation as an outstanding stallion station and farm, and is home to the Qatar Racing stallions, as well as the majority of the operation's band of broodmares.



Over the years, following its conversion to a public stud in 1995, Tweenhills has steadily expanded with the addition of five neighbouring farms. The first acquisition was Corsend Farm, which is now home to the Foaling Unit. Another, Chargy Hill, is predominantly a yearling farm and Catsbury is home to the Isolation Unit. A further 60 acres of grazing was purchased at Hartpury Court with a new purpose-built barn for mares. There are plans to renovate the historic barn next to the church into an events and wedding venue. There has also been investment in several outdoor all-weather paddocks, new winter barns and a three-furlong all-weather trotting ring for foal, yearling and stallion exercise.





As well as producing its own oats, barley, hay and haylage, every acre is farmed in rotation with our large resident Aberdeen Angus suckler herd numbering 200. Tweenhills Angus Beef is produced from the grass-fed herd and expertly prepared and packed by the farm's local butcher. Among the regular clients of Tweenhills Angus Beef are Gloucester Rugby Club and a number of local restaurants. It is also used by the Tweenhills Angus Burger Van which helps to raise funds for Racing Welfare at the Tattersalls December Sales. The beef has a wonderful rich depth of flavour with a fine marbling texture that the Aberdeen Angus is renowned for.

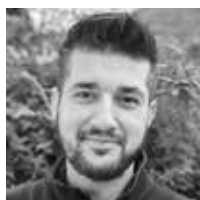
