Tweenhills | 2026

A big anniversary is cause for reflection in this part of Gloucestershire.

It's hard to imagine it has been 30 years since I convinced my long-suffering parents that buying Afzal for £8,000 and standing him as a National Hunt stallion at the family farm was a sound business plan. Extraordinary really, that they ran with it.

But 1996 was a kind year to us. Lady Rebecca, bought for just £400 and trained by the rookie Venetia Williams, wins a hat-trick of bumpers before her career really takes off and Oatis Rose, bought for £1,500 and owned by my mother and Alex Figg, wins the Hoechst Panacur Mares' Final at Newbury. I've stayed at home to paint the new stallion boxes and vividly recall my late father thumping the arm of his chair in delight as a relatively unknown Paul Carberry steers her around an impossibly tight inside line to win that valuable prize at 33/1. Afzal goes on to cover 100 mares that season thanks to the exploits of Brownhall and Billygoat Gruff and our fate is sealed.

Jump forward to 2006 and the full transition from National Hunt stud to commercial Flat breeding enterprise is complete. Flashy Wings, bred on the farm by ourselves, Richard Pegum and Stephen Hillen, had been crowned Champion 2yo the previous season and finishes runner-up in the Gr.1 Coronation Stakes. The same team goes on to breed Radiohead who wins the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes at Royal Ascot.

We have the Leading UK First-Season Sire in Ishiguru, as his Hellvelyn wins the 2006 Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, and Lucky Story, standing at the farm on behalf of Darley, has his first foals hitting the ground which will go on to make him Champion First-Season Sire. By the end of the year, we will have bought Sleeping Indian to stand alongside Trade Fair and have them both fully syndicated. We are flying.

2010 and the wheels have come off. Within six months Lucky Story and Ishiguru, both hugely popular, are dead. Ishiguru with a broken leg and Lucky Story in his sleep. I head out to Karaka yearling sales to try my hand at buying a few colts to sell at their Ready to Run Sale

and within 24 hours of landing, my little sister Di tells me that a young Sheikh Fahad, keen to buy his first racehorse, would like to meet me in London. I fly straight back and within two years we have won a Gr.1 Cheveley Park with Lightening Pearl and a Gr.1 Melbourne Cup with Dunaden, and one of the great partnerships is born.

2016 and we are flying again. Laura, Charlie, Hubie, Fenella and I have finally moved back in to Tweenhills after a major refurbishment. We have just won our first classic with Simple Verse and we have three stallions at Tweenhills including Havana Gold, whose yearlings are about to make him Leading UK First-Season Sire with amongst others, the breed-shaper Havana Grey in his first crop. In September, long-serving assistant Hannah Wall, has spotted an easy-moving grey colt in the Taylor Made draft at Keeneland and the son of Kitten's Joy will be purchased by us on behalf of Qatar Racing for just \$160,000. Roaring Lion will go on to be our first World Champion.

In 2026 I might not be the new fresh-faced young stud master I once was, but the ambition burns as bright as ever and with our fantastic team, led by the Godolphin Stud and Stable Staff Leadership award winner Ivo Thomas, we offer a world-class service. With pinhooking, breeding and racing partnerships, we strive to make this wonderful business accessible to all and welcome any approach, big or small.

Over these 30 years, Tweenhills has been forged into a world-class facility with a world-class team of horsemen and women. We have a record-breaking young sire in Kameko and a farm producing athletes winning Gr.1s all over the world.

People and horses do come and go. There are triumphs and disasters, but what holds firm are friendships, teamwork, horsemanship and the one absolute fundamental is this wonderful stock-rearing land in our beautiful corner of Gloucestershire.

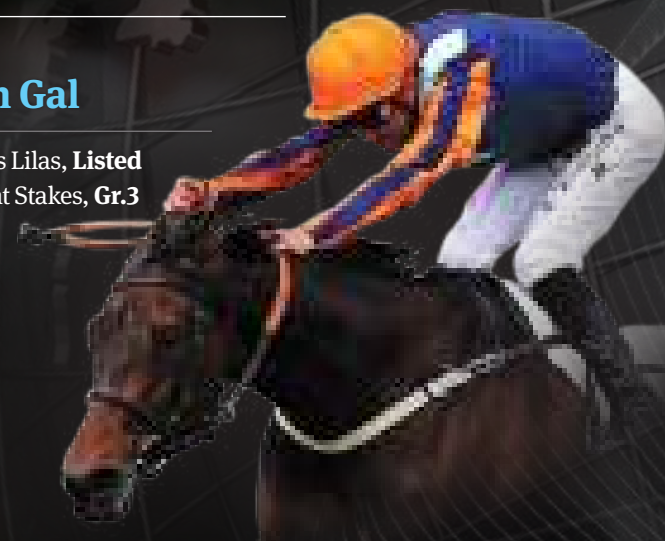

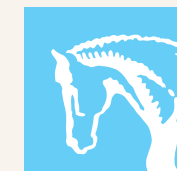

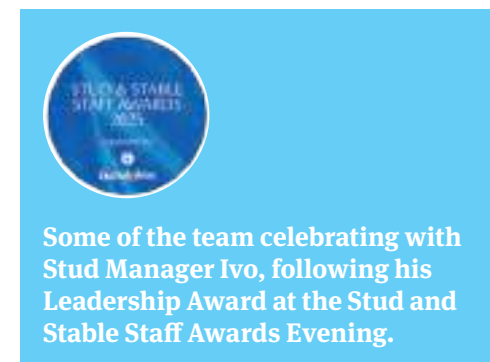
